Camp Near Look Out Mt
Tenn Oct 31st

1863

Dear Lizzie

As some of the Arch
are going to Chattanooga to day
I shall have a chance to send this
I Recd a letter from you yesterday
dated Oct 5th and one from
George Goetche he wrote me
that Mary had not Received
any letter from me I wrote
one to her a day or two before
we left Bristol Station Va
and one ~~from~~^{to} you. You did
not write whether you had got
it or not. The night that we
arrived here the 29th of Oct
we had a fight Our Brig was
engaged Our Regt and the
734 Ohio charged 6 Regts of
Rebs and drove them out of
their Breast works they charged
up a steep hill it was a Splend

Charge but our Boys suffered
heavily and Regt lost some
80 or 90 Men do not know the
exact loss have not heard yet
George Pick is all Right
we had killed in our Company
Sgt Adams Sgt Knapp
Priv of C Wheat John McLaughlin
Sgt Hill there was another
man wounded I will
let you know in my next
my love to all good bye
William

Cpl Underwood was badly
wounded and the captain
was killed
